ANSWER KEY

- 1.D.** "Seth" is correct. According to Genesis 4:25, Adam and Eve had a son named Seth. He would become the ancestor of the godly line of people on earth.
- 2.D.** "Methuselah" is correct. According to Genesis 5:27, he lived for 969 years! No one else in the Bible lived that long.
- 3.A.** "Lot was Abram's nephew." is correct. According to Genesis 12:5, Lot was Abram's nephew. Lot decided to travel with Abram and his family on their journey to Canaan.
- 4.D.** "Dreamer" is correct. According to Genesis 37:19, Joseph's brothers mocked him by calling him a "dreamer." They did not like the fact that Joseph was exalted over them in his dreams!
- 5.A.** "A snake" is correct. According to Exodus 4:3, God caused the staff to turn into a snake. When Moses saw this happen, he ran away from the snake!
- 6.B.** "Joshua" is correct. According to Joshua 1:1-6, God told Joshua to lead the Israelites into Canaan. God promised Joshua that He would be with Joshua and give him victory in Canaan.
- 7.C.** "David" is correct. According to Ruth 4:22, David was her great-grandson. This also means that Ruth was one of the ancestors of Jesus!
- 8.B.** "Proverbs" is correct. According to 1 Kings 4:32, Solomon spoke 3,000 proverbs and 1,005 songs. Many of his proverbs are recorded in the book of the Bible called "Proverbs."
- 9.D.** "Ravens" is correct. According to 1 Kings 17:6, ravens brought food to Elijah in the morning and in the evening. It would have been both odd and miraculous for Elijah to have his food delivered in that way.
- 10.C.** "Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego" is correct. According to Daniel 1:7, their Hebrew names were Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah.
