We know how important it is for you to instill the love of reading within the children in your life. The Zonderkidz I Can Read fiction and nonfiction booklist

gives young readers opportunities to explore the world of books, experience the excitement of reading about the adventures of favorite and trusted characters, and also discover God's creation and love all while introducing vocabulary and other literacy skills in a time-tested and reliable way.

I Can Read books have been introducing young readers to books since 1957. The titles in each level are written very deliberately. Readers are introduced to age- and skill-appropriate vocabulary and reading skills in an educationally sound way. These books are perfect for at-home as well as classroom use.

The Zondervan I Can Read fiction and nonfiction booklist has titles in 3 levels:

- » My First
- » Beginning Reading level 1
- » Reading with Help level 2


I Can Read "My First" books are ideal for the very early reader just learning print and book features such as letters, words, sentences, and illustrations. Young children at this stage will benefit from finger pointing at each word as you and she move through the text. As you read these My First titles with your child, think out loud as the characters and plot develop. This means making statements such as, "I wonder what they will do next?" before you turn a page or talking about the illustration and how it shows what the words are saying.

I Can Read "Beginning Reading level 1" books have simple sentences and many high frequency sight words. (Sight words are those words that occur very often and should become automatically recognizable such as a, and, the, yes, no, and please. These words do not always follow the rules we use to figure words out such as long and short

vowel sounds or hard and soft sounding C.) As you model reading, children will become more familiar with print concepts and will be able to identify many words independently at this level.

I Can Read "Reading with Help level 2" books have high interest themes and ideas. Level 2 books build on and reinforce the child's prior knowledge. Early readers will take risks and self-navigate text using a range of literacy skills gained from previous experiences like sounding out words, noticing word patterns, and use of punctuation marks. He might try to read words that look similar to one he already knows or predict what is coming because of clues in an illustration.

As you read through the titles on each level you will begin to notice that your child is moving through progressively more difficult text and on her way to making meaningful connections as an independent thinker and learner.

SO, WHERE TO BEGIN?

Talk about books first. Whether at home or in a classroom we cannot take it for granted that a child knows all about what a book is! Give your reader, or everyone in a small group, a book and talk about books in general:

- » What is a book?
- » Where are the pages?
- » Where are the cover and back of the book?
- » Point to the title.
- » Who is the author and where is her name?
- » What is a spine on a book? Show me.
- » What are illustrations? Where is the illustrator's name?
- » Are there illustrations or photos in the book?

NOW TALK ABOUT SPECIFIC BOOKS

You do not want your young reader to have her first reading experience be frustrating, so a general rule of thumb is if a child is unable to read five words on a given page, it is likely too difficult for independent reading.

An easy way to check this is to have the child place her hand flat on a table top, palm up. Each time she struggles with a word as she reads, she should curl up a finger.** If she makes a fist before the page is complete, try the next level down or read this one together.

**Note: In some of the nonfiction titles such as Bible stories there may be proper names of people and places that children do not recognize or know (Nebuchadnezzar, for example). These do not need to be counted in the five-finger rating of books.

HOW CAN YOU KNOW IF YOUR CHILD IS UNDERSTANDING WHAT IS BEING READ?

It is very important for young readers to connect with what they are reading. Can they relate to what the story is about? Does it have anything to do with the world around them? Are there ideas in one book that are similar to another they have read? One way to get students reading thoughtfully is to have before, during, and after reading questions. This type of activity works for both fiction and nonfiction and when working with one child at home or in a larger group in a classroom. The questions below can be tweaked to work for either genre.

BEFORE READING

Build background knowledge and set purpose—talk about the book.

What does the cover illustration tell us about what we are going to read?

Who are the author and illustrator? What are their roles?

What kind of book is this? Fiction? Nonfiction? How do you know?

What can we learn from fiction and nonfiction texts?

Preview new vocabulary.

What are some strategies you can use to figure out a word you do not know?

What do you already know about _____?

What do you think is going to happen? (Check predictions as you read.)

SET A PURPOSE FOR READING

Can you look at the pictures and predict what you think will happen in this book?

What makes you think that?

What characters do you think might be in our story?

Do you think there will be a problem in this story? Why or why not?

Does the topic/story relate to you or your family? How?









DURING READING

Engage students in the reading, solidify their understanding of a text.

Why is end punctuation important? Find examples in the story. (period, comma, quotation marks, exclamation point)

Does the text remind you of something you know or believe?

Who are the characters in the story?

What is the setting? (Where)

What is the plot? What is happening to the characters? (Beginning, middle, end, problem, and solution)

What pictures stand out as you read?

What can the pictures tell us about the characters, setting, and plot?

What is the author trying to say?

What do you think will happen next?
How do you know?

What can you tell me about the story so far?

Find examples of discovery, imagination, and suspense in the story.

Can you predict how the story will end?

Why do you think the character did _____?

What would you have done if you were the character?

How would you have felt if you were the character? (use different characters)

As I read ______, it made me picture _____ in my head. What pictures do you see in your head?

What did the author mean by

As you read, what are you wondering about? Put what you've just read in your own words.

AFTER READING

Check understanding, respond to the book, and make deep connections.

What do you understand from what you just read?

What is the author's purpose for writing this book?

What are the main idea and details?

How do you know the theme or central idea of the book?

How can you relate the theme to your own life?

In your opinion, was it a good title for this book? Why or why not?

Were your predictions about the story correct?

If there was a problem, did it get solved?

What happened because of the problem?

What is the most important point the author is trying to make in his writing?

What was your favorite part of the story/book?

Why did you like this book? Why didn't you?

Did you learn a lesson? What was the lesson?

Discuss something new that you learned from the book.

If you could change one thing in the story, what would it be?

Can you retell the story in order?

If you were _____, how would you have felt?

What is the most interesting situation in the story?

Is there a character in the story like you? How are you alike?

Does the book remind you of another book that you have read?

Extension lessons check comprehension and give opportunities for children to apply knowledge and actively participate in shared reading, writing, speaking, and listening activities after a book has been read and discussed.

FICTION

- Choose an important character from the story. Create a list of words that describes the character. Use examples from the story.
- Write a letter to the author telling how you personally connect with the story. What did you learn?
- Draw a picture of the story's setting. List what you would hear, see, smell, taste, feel, and know about if you could go there.
- Create a character collage for your favorite character using magazines and construction paper. Cut out words and images that reflect your character. Share with the class.
- 5 Find a quote from the book and draw a picture of what it means to you. Write a sentence describing the saying in your own words. Share with the class.

NONFICTION

- 1 Draw a main idea and detail web about the book.
- 2Choose a plant or animal from a nonfiction title such as the I Can Read Made by God series. Research facts about the plant or animal and present using pictures and words.
- Create a class mural of a habitat. Use recycled materials found in the home and school.
- Pick a real animal, insect, or creature from a book. Find a fictional book with the same animal, insect, or creature. Compare and contrast the behaviors and characteristics of real and fictional characters.
- 5Go on a word hunt. Find words in the book that are new to you. Write the words down. Describe how you unlocked the meaning of the word. Did you look it up in the dictionary? Use context or picture clues? Hang the words on a "word wall" in the classroom.
