- ★ Jesus is King of my life (Exodus 20:3; Psalm 29:10–11; Acts 2:33–36; Revelation 5:11–14).
- ★ I am who Christ says I am (1 Peter 2:9; Ephesians 1:13–14; Colossians 3:3, 12).
- ★ I take every thought captive (2 Corinthians 10:5; Romans 12:2; Philippians 4:8–9; Lamentations 3:20–24).
- ★ I smash every lie that enters my mind (2 Corinthians 10:5; Isaiah 28:15–18, 29; 2 Corinthians 6:16; Hebrews 12:1–3; 1 John 5:6–12, 20).
- ★ My purpose is to love, serve, glorify, and enjoy God forever (1 John 4:19; Acts 17:28; Romans 3:23–24; Psalm 37:4; Deuteronomy 6:4–5; Matthew 22:35–40; Mark 12:28–31; Luke 10:25–28; Joshua 22:5; Psalm 100:1–5; Isaiah 61:10; 1 Corinthians 8:6, 10:31).
- ★ I am filled with the Holy Spirit (John 14:26; 1 Corinthians 6:19; Galatians 5:25; Ephesians 1:13–14; Titus 3:4–7; 2 Corinthians 1:21–22, 3:17–18).
- ★ The same power that resurrected Christ from the dead lives in me (Romans 8:11; Ephesians 1:15–23, especially 19–20; Hebrews 13:20–21).

- ★ I am God's kid and he thinks I'm wonderful (Matthew 3:17; Zephaniah 3:17; Psalm 149:4; Genesis 1:26–31; Ephesians 5:1–2; Colossians 3:12; 1 Thessalonians 1:4; James 1:17–18; John 1:12–13, 14:18; 1 John 3:1–3).
- ★ I am fearfully and wonderfully made (Psalm 139:14; Genesis 1:26–27, 2:7, 22), beautiful beyond measure (Song of Songs 4:7; 2 Corinthians 3:18; Ecclesiastes 3:11; Zechariah 9:16–17; Isaiah 61:1–3; Deuteronomy 7:6).
- ★ The power of God guards my thoughts (Philippians 4:7–8; Proverbs 2:1–5, 4:20–23; 9:10), the Word of God guides my steps (Psalm 119:105; 2 Timothy 3:14–17; Proverbs 30:5; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; Hebrews 4:12), and the favor of God rests on me (Philippians 1:2; Luke 2:14; 2 Corinthians 6:2).
- ★ Worry is not my boss (Matthew 6:25; Isaiah 41:10; Psalm 27:1, 42:11, 86:5–7; Philippians 4:6–7).
- ★ I trust in the Lord with all my heart and lean not on my understanding. In all my ways I will acknowledge him, and He will make my paths straight (Proverbs 3:5–6; Psalm 20:7, 28:7, 91:2; Jeremiah 39:18; Nahum 1:7; Romans 15:13).
- ★ The Lord is my shepherd. I don't need anything more than he's given me. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul (Psalm 23:1–3; John 10:11, 14–16; Revelation 7:9–17).
- ★ God is my strength (Psalm 28:7, 73:26; Nehemiah 8:10; Isaiah 40:28–31; Philippians 4:13), my shield (Proverbs 30:5; Psalm 3:3; Ephesians 6:16). He's always with me (Matthew

28:20; Luke 15:31), always for me (Psalm 56:9; Romans 5:8, 8:31–34), always sees me (2 Chronicles 16:9; Genesis 16:13–14; Psalm 33:12–15; Luke 1:46–49; 1 Samuel 16:7).

- ★ No weapon formed against me will prosper (Isaiah 54:17; Psalm 91:1–16; Ephesians 6:10–18; Isaiah 2:4; 2 Timothy 4:18; 1 Corinthians 15:50–58; 2 Corinthians 1:21; Romans 8:35–39; 2 Timothy 4:18).
- ★ I am anointed, empowered, and called to reach people who don't know God (Luke 4:18; Romans 1:16; Matthew 28:18–20; John 14:12–17; Acts 1:8; Ephesians 4:7–13; 2 Peter 1:3).
- ★ My words have power (Proverbs 18:21; Acts 15:30–34; James 5:13–16; 1 Thessalonians 5:9–11; Hebrews 3:13).
- ★ I will look for every opportunity to speak life (Proverbs 15:4; 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18), show compassion (Matthew 14:14; Philippians 2:1–2; Colossians 3:12), and bring out the best in others (Colossians 4:6; Jeremiah 29:7; 1 Corinthians 10:24; 1 Thessalonians 5:15; Philippians 1:9–10).

- ★ I refuse to listen to Satan (Colossians 1:13, John 10:10; 1 Peter 5:8–10; ), or freak out when things don't go my way (1 Peter 4:12; Exodus 14:13; 2 Chronicles 20:17; Psalm 20:7–8; Luke 21:17; 1 Corinthians 15:58, 16:13; Philippians 1:27; 2 Thessalonians 2:15; James 5:8).
- ★ God works all things together for my good and his glory (Romans 8:28; Jeremiah 29:11; Psalm 27:13; Psalm 44:26, 79:9; Isaiah 58:8; John 1:14, 17:24; Romans 5:2; 2 Corinthians 4:6, 15; 1 Peter 5:10; Revelation 21:1–5).
