

Comparisons of Passages in Mark

1:14–15

After John was **handed over**, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God:

The time [καιρός] has been fulfilled, and **the kingdom of God has arrived**.

Change your ways and believe this **gospel**.

14:41–42

And he comes a third time and says to them:

Continue to sleep and take your rest. It is enough.

The hour [ώρα] has come: see, **the Son of Man is handed over** into the hands of sinners. Get up, let us go; see, **the one who hands me over has arrived**.

15:37–39

And Jesus uttered a loud cry and breathed his last/the **spirit**, and the veil in the temple was **torn** in two

from top to bottom.

And when the centurion who stood facing him

saw how he breathed his last/the **spirit**,

he said,

“Truly, this man was **Son of God!**”

1:10–11

And immediately, ascending out of the water, he saw the heavens **torn** apart and the **spirit** like a dove **descending** upon him.

And a voice came from the heavens:

“You are my **beloved Son**, in you I am well pleased.”
